Discourse in the Data Decoding European Political Communication

April 19 2024, University of Amsterdam with Prof. Dr. Christian Rauh

In an era of frequent crises in Europe, effective political communication is essential. Political leaders must master crisis communication to inform and lead their constituents. The "Discourse in the Data" workshop focuses on quantitative and qualitative text analysis in European political communication. It explores how to apply these methods across different sources for better understanding political discourse at the national and EU levels.

We invite early career scholars engaged with topics relating to (crisis) communication strategies at both the national and EU level to apply by submitting an abstract describing your methodological approach to political text analysis in Europe.
